Objectives:

- To know more about daily life as a missionary through multiple ways of doing ministry.
- Live a fun, thrilling, enriching and unforgettable adventure!
- Live an experience to make you grow spiritually and discover the powerful hand of God.
- Learn to trust God more and laugh at obstacles or difficulties along our path.
- Discover new places, people and communities.

- Open up to other horizons; other ways of thinking and acting.

PÁGE 2

1-Selection criteria:

- must be 16 years of age or older. (under 18 years of age, parental permission is required)
- must be in good health
- must be available to serve others; attitude of humility and obedience.
- must have a very good ability to adapt to change and be flexible.
- respect cultural differences.

AND

- be a born-again Christian and have a basic knowledge of the Bible.
- must be open to learn and manifest the power of God.
- be thirsty to know better the love of the Heavenly Father in action.
- commitment: be ready to dedicate oneself and become a disciple.

2-Questionnaire (online form to be completed)

- a) fill out a questionnaire to get to know you better. (Your growth in Jesus, your faith, your beliefs, your ability to adapt, your respect for other cultures, the state of your heart, your health, etc.)
- b) know your interests for the mission: gifts, evangelizing, preaching, praising God, visiting orphans, detoxification center, etc.
- c) make video lectures together (with you, your pastor and a member of your family).
- d) 1-2 references required (pastor, parents, guardians, etc.).

3-Programming of activities***:

- Experience healings and personal deliverances.
- Evangelize in the streets, parks and other places.
- Participate in or organize evangelistic activities.
- Helping the poor in need. (e.g. donate food or clothing)
- Visit churches and families located in communities, villages and towns.
- Visit orphaned children, refugee, detoxification or incarceration centres.
- Participate in the worship (songs, instruments, dance).
- Teach and preach the Word to congregation members and "online".
- Prayer with the laying on of hands.
- Caring for stray or abandoned animals.
- All other related tasks within the service: e.g. Make food, cleaning, place chairs in church, etc.

Bible verse: The greatest among you will be your servant. Matthew 23:11

Important details:

*Be aware that the programming of activities may vary depending on the opportunities that arise. We also take into account the interests, gifts and desires of each person in training.

**We take into account that it is important to have time of rest, rejuvenation and entertainment through the mission.

***We provide support and a framework to each person through this experience.

4- - Preparation:

- Prepare spiritually: Fasting and praying, meditation on the Word of God, talking to your pastor and family. Seek support from your church, family, and friends.
- Save money and/or seek financial support (e.g. fundraising activities)
- Start learning the language of the country you plan to visit (e.g. Spanish using the "Duolingo" App)
- Read a document on the reality of being a missionary: e.g. "Third Culture Kids" (co-authored by Dave Pollock and Ruth Van Reken)

Requirements:

- 1. Have travel health insurance (Mandatory).
- 2. Provide a budget and finance to cover expenses (Visa, Transportation: round-trip airfare, bus, taxi; Food, Personal expenses, etc.)
- 3. Have a valid passport and visa (if required).
- 4. Provide the name and contact information of a "reference person" in case of emergency.

What to think about bringing?

- Bring the essentials on a trip (e.g. 1 small suitcase)
- If you have medication to take, make sure you have it for the duration of the trip.
- Bring comfortable, decent and appropriate clothing for the different circumstances and different climates (cool, hot, very hot).

Example:

1 shorts, 2 t-shirts, 1 jeans pants, 1 sports pants, 2 clean pants, 5 shirts, 1-2 warm sweater, underwear and stockings for 5-7 days

OR

3-4 Dresses y 1-2 skirts (knees or lower) and 5 blouses

AND

- 1 bathing suit
- 1 warm coat
- 1 pair of sunglasses and sunscreen

Option: hat or cap

Hygiene accessories (toothbrush, toothpaste, threads clean teeth, hairbrush, etc.)

AND

- Bible, notebook/pen or note taking on "One note" application
- Tissue or toilet
- Gel to disinfect hands
- Earplugs
- Drugs for diarrhea and stomach upset, Acetaminophens

Before your stay:

- Make sure that you are ready and able to do the mission so that it is a positive and enriching experience.
- If necessary, provide you with a *letter of invitation to obtain your Visa.
- Equipe you as much as possible before the mission.
- Train, guide and support you before, during and after the mission.
- Help you identify and clarify your gifts, talents and calling.

During your stay:

- Organize the program of activities.
- Take care of your well-being and safety.
- Train, support and guide you.
- Answer your questions.

Follow-up after:

- Encourage you to continue your learning and your spiritual journey.
- Encourage you to put it into practice in your country or other country.
